

Airdrie Public Library Code of Conduct

To ensure that ALL visitors to Airdrie Public Library are able to use the resources and services available at the library, the following guidelines for behaviour have been determined.

Visitors to the library are required to respect others and the library staff. Behaviour that may interfere with library services, employees, or other visitors is prohibited. This behaviour includes but is not limited to:

- excessively loud noise or disorderly conduct, such as running, loud or abusive language or drunkenness;
- possession or use of alcohol or illegal drugs;
- mutilation, defacement or theft of library property;
- use of furniture, equipment or facilities in a manner for which they were not intended or designed;
- harassing or threatening other visitors or employees; and
- acts which impair the safe and efficient operation of the library.

Violation of these guidelines may result in loss of library privileges as well as the right to enter the library building.
